

BRIEF ITEMS from Neighboring Towns

ONTARIO

It was announced this week that Ontario will have a new 750 seat theater incorporating the latest plans incorporated in theatre construction. Estimated cost of construction is between sixty and seventy thousand dollars, Howard Matthews of the Roxy Theatre stated.

City lots priced at more than \$10,500 in the aggregate were sold by the city council on Monday.

The Chicago Bridge & Iron company was successful bidder on the erection of the new 400,000 gallon water tank which will be a unit in the new water system program.

VALE

Fred Berry and Leo Heleniak, owners of the Vale Creamery, announced this week that they will

start remodeling shortly after the first of the year with building expansion to follow later in the year designed to install a modern locker system with 1200 new all steel lockers.

Sixty tracts of county owned land were sold at auction last week. The total returns from the sale amounted to \$13,500.

EMMETT

The bureau of reclamation will have one more year of battling the million yard dirt slide on Little Freezeout hill near Emmett before a project, now completed, will overcome the difficulty.

Materials on the ground and construction work is scheduled to begin immediately on an addition to the Gem Fruit Packing plant. The cost

of the addition will be about \$10,000.

Saunders, of Toledo, Ohio, president of Saunders Mills, Inc., is here this week to inspect the local alfalfa meal plant and to supervise the installation of dustless equipment to take care of the present condition relative to dust.

WEISER

Sugar beet shipments from the Weiser area totaling 872 carloads were handled by the Union Pacific railroad in operations that ended on Saturday. The shipment totalled over 36,000 tons, as compared to last year's good total of 475 carloads. Financiers in Eastern centers seem to be willing to invest money in promising mining properties according to John Glass who is opening a mining office in Weiser. He believes that much work will be done in western mining fields during 1946 unless strikes hold up material and labor costs sky rocket.

Chipped Enamel Ware

There is danger in using chipped enamelware. Now about copper. Acid foods shouldn't be cooked in copper vessels. Miss Lawrence says. And milk and foods containing saccharine shouldn't be kept in copper containers, since acids they contain may dissolve the copper. Furthermore, never fry foods in copper pans. Cooking foods in brass may not be harmful, but off-flavors may make the food impossible to eat. And incidentally, lead made in an iron pot will become rancid more quickly than lead made in steel or aluminum kettles.

Lumber Manufacturing

The lumber manufacturing industry is made up of 38,895 individual units. Several of the larger manufacturing concerns have their own research laboratories and have contributed greatly toward the solution of waste use problems, but the remainder of the mills are so small in size that they cannot undertake much, if anything, in the way of research.

Vitamin Rich

Tomatoes are the second richest available source of vitamin C, being exceeded in vitamin C content only by oranges. Easy to grow in most soils they require plenty of sunshine and moderate even soil moisture. In addition to vitamin C they are good for vitamin A. They are a palatable food, canned or fresh, served as a juice or in pickles and relishes. They are the easiest vegetable to can. They can be eaten raw. No. 1 for home gardens. They can be grown over a long season.

Strengthens Joint

Animal glue sticks to wood because in its thin, warm solution it penetrates the pores while still fluid. When it solidifies and dries, its tremendous shrinking power draws the fibers of one piece to the other, making the joint stronger than the wood itself and of equal durability.

Strengthen Seam

To strengthen a narrow or loosely stitched seam on an inexpensive garment—a house dress, for example—re-stitch seam about 1/16 inch deeper. Set machine at 14 to 16 stitches per inch. On a better garment, rip out and re-stitch with broken, knobby, drawn or crooked stitching. If material frays, run a row of machine stitching near the cut edges.

Retina of Eye

The retina of the eye is not fastened to the inside of the eye, except at the edges of the cornea. The retina is held in place by the pressure of the jelly-like fluid in the interior of the eye.

Towel Hems

When bopping towels examine the hems for a clue to their worth. Hems should be turned back carefully and sewed with fine stitches. Corners should be neatly backstitched.

Glue in Horn Piths

Contrary to popular belief, the horns and horns of animals do not yield glue. But the piths of the horns are good sources of raw material.

Bands Abrasive

Animal glue binds the abrasive to the wheels and belts used in polishing planes. By polishing instead of painting planes, several hundred pounds in weight are saved, and speed is greatly increased.

Lengthen Wear

Underarm shields and a back shield keep a dress fresh longer—postpone cleaning, and lengthen wear. Sleazy trims which make a garment look cheap may sometimes be replaced by more durable trimming.

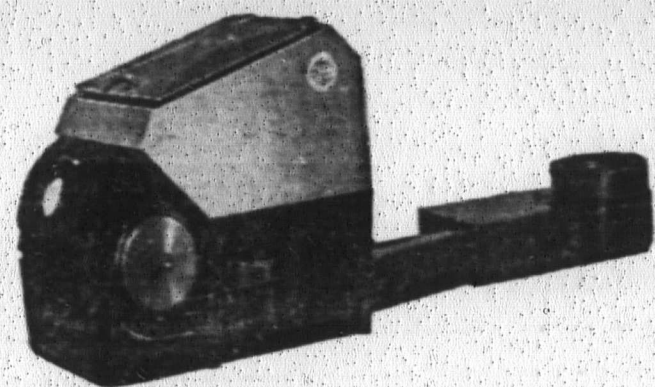
